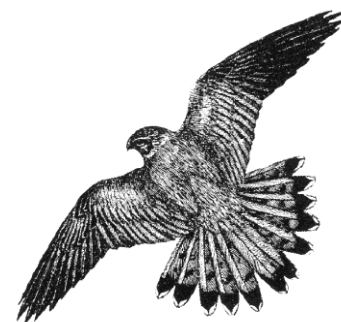

In-person early voting will be at the County Auditor’s Office 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. daily and at the Iowa City Public Library 10:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m. There will be additional temporary early voting sites later. If you requested a ballot by mail, those ballot mailings started at the end of September. Redistricting created some new voting places, which you can also check at the website.

The following offices and issues appear on the ballot, some depending on your locality

- President and Vice President of the United States
- U S Representative, 2nd Congressional District
- State Representative (5 Johnson County districts)
- County Supervisor (three seats)
- County Auditor
- County Sheriff
- Ag Extension Council (4 seats)
- Soil and Water Conservation Commission (3 seats)
- Township Trustees (two per rural township)
Madison Twp: 3rd trustee, two-year term to fill vacancy
Washington Twp: 3rd trustee and clerk, two-year terms to fill vacancy
- Judicial retention (yes or no for judges to remain in office)
- Hills City Council: one seat, a one-year term to fill vacancy
- Tiffin City Council: two seats, one-year terms to fill vacancies
- County ballot issue: Justice Center
- Hills ballot issue: water utility

Rich Walker has taken a position at the University of Michigan, so this course will be taught by Acie Earl. Earl, a four-year UI letter winner, graduated in 1992 as the Big Ten all-time leader in blocked shots. Earl was the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year in his junior year. The Boston Celtics drafted him as the 19th first round pick in 1993. He played worldwide 1998-2004, winning 3 MVP awards and two championships. Currently he is a graduate teaching assistant at Iowa and will receive his graduate degree this fall. He also coaches Venom Sports boys and girls travel teams.
