

Report of the UIRA Membership Committee  
Annual Meeting, April 5, 2019

UIRA currently has 668 members, representing 508 households. The number of members is basically constant compared with a year ago when we had 676 at this time.

The membership committee consists of myself, the Membership Chair, and Charles Dayton, Assistant to the Treasurer, and Diana Harris, the Gray Hawk Editor.

This is the fifth year that a \$25 membership fee for three years has been available and 380 members currently take advantage of that discount. Last year we had 362 members at the \$25 level.

As of June 30, the membership of 352 of our 668 members will expire. That means 53% of our members will need to make payment this year to maintain their membership. An email reminder will be sent in May to those whose membership expires on June 30, 2019. Last year 384 reminders were sent with 279 members renewing for a 73% response. Members should not send a dues payment unless they receive a reminder. Those who have not provided an email address will receive a reminder by U.S. mail.

The board voted to deliver *Gray Hawks* by email (electronic delivery) beginning in September 2014. At this time, only 19 households receive their *Gray Hawks* by postal mail.
