

UIRA Membership Committee 2019 – 2020 Annual Report

UIRA currently has 630 members, representing 488 households. Last year we had 668 members representing 508 households.

The membership committee consists of myself, the Membership Chair; Charles Dayton, Assistant to the Treasurer; and Diana Harris, Gray Hawk Editor.

This is the sixth year that a \$25 membership fee for three years has been available. Currently 413 members take advantage of that discount. Last year we had 380 members at the \$25 level.

As of June 30, the membership of 399 of our 630 members will expire. That means 63% of our members will need to make payment this year to maintain their membership. Renewal reminders were sent at the beginning of June to those whose membership expires on June 30, 2020.

Members should not send a dues payment unless they receive a reminder. Those who have not provided an email address will receive a reminder by U.S. mail.

The board voted to deliver Gray Hawks by email (electronic delivery) beginning in September 2014. At this time, only 13 households receive their Gray Hawks by postal mail.
